## Salvia nemorosa 'Crystal Blue' Crystal Blue Sage

Salvia nemorosa "Crystal Blue' (Crystal Blue Sage) is unique among sages for its delicate, pale blue flowers. The fragrance of flowers and crushed leaves is refreshingly herbal. This plant is well-suited to mass plantings in borders or in a potted patio arrangement. Good drainage and full sun are essential conditions for this plant. From May to July, this plant boasts dense flower spires that attract bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds. The pale blue flower spikes contrast well against the dark gray-green, wrinkled leaves. The tidy, compact form of this plant makes a neat addition to the garden. Trimming back spent flowers can encourage re-blooming in later in the season. The flowers are great in cut or dried arrangements that bring the pleasant scent indoors. This tough plant is tolerant of drought, salt, heat, and resists herbivore browse.
