## Veronica longifolia 'Eveline' Eveline Speedwell

Veronica longifolia 'Eveline' (Eveline Speedwell) brings bold spikes of magenta-pink flowers to the summer garden. Dark green, lance-shaped foliage (4" long blades) emerges in spring. Plants have upright form and each stem is topped with several vertical, tapered flower spikes, resembling candelabras. Densely flowered, magenta-pink spikes are on display from June until August, attracting bees, butterflies, hummingbirds and other pollinators. As temperatures cool in fall, Eveline foliage takes on deep purplish-red hues. Plants are a compact size, reaching up to 2' tall in flower and 1-1.5' wide. Plants prefer full sun, but will tolerate part shade. Does best with consistently moist, well-drained soils. It is resistant to herbivore browse and tolerant of road salt and hot conditions.
